I served as chief of staff to then Representative Phil King (now serving as State Senator) for numerous legislative sessions and special sessions.

Most recently as the Election Integrity Director for the RPT, I have traveled across Texas recruiting and training hundreds of activists to be poll watchers. I have worked with local GOP and grassroots leaders to magnify and problem solve on local election integrity concerns. During the 88th Legislature alone, I registered or testified on 117 bills at the Capitol according to Grassroots America, We The People. I was a key leader in Texas exiting the ERIC system, a program funded by George Soros that harvested personal data giving it to leftist organizations, which then targeted voters to advance progressive candidates and causes in Texas. We MUST NOT ever allow anything like this to happen again. There is more work to be done on election integrity at the Capitol and I am the very best person to be your voice on our legislative priorities.

I also know from firsthand experience, the difference the state party can make in assisting and building up the local party apparatus. It is imperative our state party lead on fundraising to support candidates across the state and in our own Senate district. We must lead in party organization to support our local GOPs. Without support, our local parties suffer, which then affects the trajectory of the entire county. I believe I can be part of this change to make the SREC more effective for our local needs in SD 25.
